2024 PCORC INFORMATION

BASIC SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

1. All paddlers must wear a HI-VIS life jacket and clothing

2. All paddlers must have their leash attached at all times

3. All Skis must wear a jacket style PFD. Only Outriggers and SUPs can wear an inflatable bum bag life jacket.

4. Paddlers are advised to download the SafeTrx App which will provide a live update of your position during the race and have your Emergency Contact monitor your progress.

POINTS

Pacific Coast Ocean Racing Championships will only be awarded to financial members of Paddle Queensland who have competed in at least five (5) events of the Championships.
